1. <u>In the Month of May, there will be</u> 10 A.M. services on Sunday Morning. This may have to continue into June. (no Sunday School, Nursery, or Jr. Church) Sunday and Wed. night gatherings are canceled.

2. We will still be streaming live and will be having Bible Studies online via Facebook or Zoom.

- 3. We ask you to please spread out in our auditorium. We have plenty of chairs to make this happen. Also, the good news is, there is no number limits on Family members that can sit together.
- 4. Please refrain from handshakes and hugs (this is very hard for all of us).

Just Remember **"Keeping The Distance"** is the New Friendly way of welcoming folks at O.B.B.C. Don't worry...no one will be offended.

5. We will dismiss by rows to reduce the risk of congregating or crowding in exit area. Entry and exiting to the church will be through the main front doors and through the south door.

- 6. Areas of the church such as kitchen, gym, and back hallway will be blocked off to minimize and control our sanitation. We will have a team to wipe down any high traffic areas after service.
- 7. Offering plates are located in different locations around the auditorium. We still have our kiosk, online giving, and Focus Bank drop off available.
- 8. We will also take a few pics of our service each time we meet, so we will have a record of who is in attendance in case we do have exposure of infection.
- 9. Don't ever be embarrassed to wear a mask or gloves if you feel you need to.
- 10. If you are feeling sick or if you are not quite comfortable around larger crowds...<u>IT'S</u>
 <u>OK</u> to stay home and watch online or even stay in our parking lot and listen to 87.9
 FM. It's not being paranoid...its Wisdom.
